

EXHORTATION TO CONFESS OUR SINS

From Romans 6:9-11

We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over him. ¹⁰ For the death he died he died to sin, once for all, but the life he lives he lives to God. ¹¹ So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus.

PRAYER OF CONFESSION

Based on Romans 7:12; 1 Timothy 1:5; Exodus 20:4-6

- Minister Yahweh, our God, Father, Son and Spirit, You have given us your law as an expression of who you are— You and your law are holy, righteous, and good. It is a law of love that should lead to love, but we confess we have treated the law as a means of life.
- All** **We obey the law, because we think it will give us life. We must be good people because we do what's good. We want to make ourselves acceptable by what we do.**
- Minister We confess we have treated the law as a means of death.
- All** **We avoid your law. We think it will rob us of satisfaction and kill what we enjoy. We're put off by those we think keep the law, so we run the other way and reject obedience, calling it legalism. We think love should have no rules, and we treat your law as a part of the ignorant past.**
- Minister Lord, you say, "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy."
- All** **But we forget the Sabbath and treat all seven days the same. We feel compelled to work without boundaries: We struggle to trust that you will provide for us; We believe we're defined and valued by what we do. We neglect worship, meaningful relationships, and works of mercy, saying that we don't have time, when in reality, we don't make time.**
- Minister Lord, let your law crush us.
- All** **Show us our sin!**
- Minister Lord, let your law point us to Jesus.
- All** **Show us your salvation!**
- Minister Lord, let your law guide us.
- All** **Show us your ways!**

SILENT PRAYER OF CONFESSION

In this quiet moment, ask God to simply lead you to rest in His goodness. What has taken on "saving" power for you? Bring this to God. Offer what rules your heart to God, and resting in Jesus alone... say goodbye to it.

ASSURANCE OF PARDON IN THE GOSPEL

Based on Romans 8:3–4; Galatians 3:10, 13; 4:4–5; Deuteronomy 6:5; Jeremiah 31:33

- Minister We were under the law, relying on it to save us.
- All** **But we couldn't keep the law and it had no power to save, so instead, it stood as curse over us.**
- Minister God did what the law couldn't do: He sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law,
- All** **To redeem us from the curse of the law, by becoming a curse for us.**
- Minister Jesus so loved his Father with all his heart, soul, mind, and strength,
- All** **That he gave his life according to his Father's plan to save those whom the Father had given him.**
- Minister Jesus so loved his neighbor as himself,
- All** **That he died for us while we were still sinners.**
- Minister God condemned sin by giving his Son as a sacrifice for our sins, in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us,
- All** **Who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.**
Lord, put your law in our minds and write it on our hearts!

Summary of Today's Message: New believers who come to faith later in life are in tune with their former lifestyle. Someone who defrauded people, manipulated people, and used people could write a book about their former life and their exploits. What's remarkable is that the cheer on further instruction. They are unafraid to hear biblical instruction that reveals the inner workings of their former life. This passage is instructive for all of us — it is a template for discipleship.

1. The gravitational pull of the old life and the "know how" leading to life change. (v. 1-5)
2. The grave consequences of forming one's own view morality. (v 6)
3. The gracious provision of God's authority and its structure. (v. 7-8)

AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

From *Philippians 2: 5-10*

Minister Christian, what is the mind of Christ in which you are to walk?

People Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus, who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. CELEBRATION OF THE SACRAMENT OF THE LORD'S SUPPER

MINISTER'S WELCOME TO THE TABLE

Based on *Luke 13:29, Romans 8:32*

From east and west, from north and south, people will come and take their places at the banquet in the kingdom of God. He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things? Come then to the joyful feast of the Lord and be transformed.

Minister Great is the mystery of faith:

People Christ has died! Christ has risen! Christ is coming again!

Minister Praise to you, Lord Jesus:

**People: Dying you destroyed our death.
Rising you restored our life.
Lord Jesus, come in glory.**

Minister According to his commandment:

**People We remember his death,
we proclaim his resurrection,

Minister Christ the bread of life:

**People When we eat this bread and drink this cup,

BLESSING BY THE MINISTER

As Paul said to the Corinthians, so I say to you, Christ the Passover Lamb is sacrificed for us. Let us keep the feast!

COMMUNION AT TRINITY

WHO IS INVITED TO TAKE PART? All baptized believers who have professed their faith before the leadership of a Bible believing congregation that teaches the Christian faith in terms of faith alone in Christ are invited to join us at the Lord's Table. We ask that children wait to partake in the Lord's Supper until they have met with the Elders and professed faith publicly.

WHAT IF I AM NOT READY? If you or your children are not ready to partake in the Lord's Supper, you are invited to come forward and ask the Elders to pray for you. You may also remain in your seat to sing, pray or meditate.

WHAT IS THE PROCESS? We dismiss by rows and come forward, beginning with the middle sections, then moving to the outer sections. With the elements of the Supper in hand, return to your seat and take the elements when you are ready. We encourage you to sing, pray or meditate on the finished work of Christ at this time.

PRAYER OF SEARCHING FOR TRUTH: Lord Jesus, you claim to be the way, the truth and the life. If what you claim is true, please guide me, teach me, and open to me the reality of who you are. Grant that I might be undaunted by the cost of following you as I consider the reasons for doing so. Give me an understanding of you that is coherent, convincing and leads to the life you promise. Amen.

PRAYER OF BELIEVING IN JESUS: Lord Jesus, I admit that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever before believed. But through you, I am more loved and accepted than I ever dared to hope. I thank you for paying my debt, bearing my punishment on the cross and offering forgiveness and new life. Knowing that you have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive you as my savior. Amen.

PRAYER FOR STRUGGLING AGAINST SIN: Lord Jesus, grant that I may see in you the fulfillment of all my needs, and may turn from every false satisfaction to feed on you - the true and living bread. Enable me to lay aside the sin that clings so closely to me, and run with perseverance the race that you have set before me, looking only to you, the pioneer and champion of my faith. Amen

BENEDICTION

WHAT IS WORSHIP?

In his encounter with the woman of Samaria, Jesus explained that “God is spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and in truth.” (John 4:24). The reason Jesus says true worshipers must worship in this way is because God Himself “is spirit.” Here we discover the simple yet profound principle that true worship is a response to God as He has personally revealed Himself. Thus, conformity to God’s character is the key to true worship. “Great is the LORD,” as the psalmist puts it, “and greatly to be praised” (Psalm 48:1)! In worship, we seek to reflect this divine reality, declaring with our lips and demonstrating with our lives that God is supremely precious and therefore worthy to receive all glory and honor and praise.

Why Do We Worship This Way?

Entering God’s Presence

We gather in response to God’s call to worship, joyfully offering praise to the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. With reverence and awe, we confess our sins and receive God’s forgiveness, which is declared in Jesus’ name.

Renewing Our Faith

Worship continues with a focus on God’s Word. Our faith is renewed as we publicly confess the truth of God, join our hearts and voices in prayers and hymns of praise to God, and hear the good news of God powerfully proclaimed.

Responding in Thanks

As hearing becomes doing, we respond to the proclamation of God’s Word. Songs of praise continue to be raised and the gifts and offerings of God’s people are collected. On Communion Sundays, we are invited to celebrate the Lord’s Supper. With God’s blessing upon us, we are sent into the world to love and serve the risen Lord Jesus Christ!
